Where: Tendick Park, Hwy O, Saukville. 3 miles north of Saukville on Hwy O.

Teams: Brookfield Central, Cedarburg, Cedar Grove-Belgium, Hartford Union, Homestead, Menomonee Falls, Random Lake, Sheboygan North, Shorewood, Sussex Hamilton, Wauwatosa East, Wisconsin Lutheran.

Entries: Please send roster of potential runners to runaboutsports@gmail.com by August 18th. This is to get the athlete's name on their bib number. If you are not sure someone is running just send over their name so we can have their bib prepared. If they don't run no big deal. The names on the bibs are big enough so the spectators can cheer for the athlete by name.

Enter your athletes that will compete by noon on Wednesday, August 30th. Register your athletes @ www.pttiming.com. Register online and follow directions.

The event is chipped timed. We will have timing mats at the mile and 2 mile markers and the PT Timing scoreboard at the finish line. A DJ will also be present with music.

The course is marked by flags, flagging and paint. All kilometers and miles are marked.

Fee: \$250 per school / \$125 per team

Parking: All team busses/vans will park in the lot inside of the park. All spectators will have to park on the opposite side of the course in a remote lot and take a shuttle bus or walk to the course. A donation for riding the shuttle would be appreciated. The county has put up "No Parking" signs along County Highway "O", and this will be enforced. Please inform your spectators about this policy. Spectators will need to get to the meet well before the race in order to make it to the course on time.

Awards: Medals to the top 25 in both varsity races. Ribbons to the top 50 in both junior varsity races. Individual awards will be given at the finish line. We will recognize the top ten varsity runners and present the trophies after the conclusion of the boys' varsity race. Trophies to top two varsity teams and top JV team per gender.
